How to arrive at the conference venue?

The Institute of Postharvest Technology of Sri Lanka is well connected through roads and railway lines.

Institute is approximately 170 km away from the Bandaranayake International Airport and 200 km from Colombo which is the commercial capital of Sri Lanka.

Followings are the main bus routes.

1. 87- From Jaffna, Vavuniya, Kilinochchi to Colombo via Anuradhapura, Puttalam
2. 4 - From Mannar to Colombo via Anuradhapura, Puttalam
3. 57- From Anuradhapura to Colombo via Kurunegala
4. 15 – From Anuradhapura to Colombo via Kurunegala
5. 42- From Anuradhapura to Kandy via Thalawa, Eppawala, Dambulla
6. 43- From Anuradhapura to Kandy via Maradankadawala

Railway links

1. From Colombo to Kankasanthurai via Anuradhapura
2. From Colombo to Thalaimannar via Anuradhapura
3. From Colombo to Anuradhapura

How can I apply for entry visa?

Many nationals can obtain visa on arrival. Some nationals will have to obtain visa prior to arrival.
